2009 brought St Fintans, the Junior D football championship title by the strong efforts of the clubs second team. Having fought off HWH Bunclody in Patrick's Park in the semi final 1.07 to 0.09, St Fintans came up against St James in a highly contested and entertaining final in Killurín. At the finish, St Fintans 2.8 St James 2.6.

One would have to go back further, to 1999 to find the last major championship won by St Fintans. Marshalled by two big hearted club men, Billy Rowe and Jim Rowe, they accounted for Kilmore on a scoreline of 1.07 to 1.06. Having gained promotion to intermediate ranks, they also went on a lengthy Leinster club campaign that brought them to Leinster final - only to lose out against Clara of Offaly, 0.10 to 0.09. From this 1999 panel, Niall Murphy, Adrian Murphy, Jamie Codd and Enda Newport are in the panel for 2012 team. Minor stars, Donal Shanley, Jim Rossiter, Peter Goldsmith and Jason Pettit give this 2012 panel a good balance. Tribute to the late great Martin Jordan

Tig Leath Slí - Bun Clóidí C.L.G.

July 6th 1964 to September 15th 2012

Martin Jordan was a gentleman. He was inoffensive, obliging, and loyal and he was respected by all who knew him. In his chosen profession as a carpenter he was hard working, reliable, punctual and very skilled.

Martin's main interest was the G.A.A. - he was keenly interested in the fortunes of both his County team of Wexford and his Club - Half-Way-House \ Bunclody. The amount of time, dedication, skills and expertise he gave to the club as a player, mentor and committee member was exceptional. He was an active member of both the underage and adult committees of H.W.H. \ Bunclody for more than twenty years. He also served on a number of sub committees such as St. Patrick's Day Parade, Club House and the Club Lotto on which he served as a member for 20 years and as chairman for 5. He was always available to help in any capacity that the club required.

Martin's playing career started on a high - winning u12 football in 1976, and the following year he captained the Rackard league winning team. Under the guidance of Noel O'Keeffe in the Bunclody V.E.C., Martin won u15 and 17 County Titles in '79 and '80.



He was on the historic minor squad, when H.W.H. \ Bunclody captured their first title in 1981. Four years later, in 1985, he won a County Senior Football Championship medal having lost a Junior County Final a month earlier and he won three Senior Football League medals.

The next chapter for Martin was as a mentor. For over 25 years, up to his untimely passing, he coached, managed and trained teams in the Club - u16, u18, u21, Juniors, Intermediates and Senior - in both hurling and football - with County Championship success coming his way in the form of Juvenile hurling in 1994, Minor football in both 1999 and 2000 and u21 football in 2005 and 2006.

Martin had a hugely positive influence on the development of our Club and on the youth of the Parish which should neither be underestimated nor forgotten. We owe him a debt which can never be repaid. The huge Guard of Honour from H.W.H. \ Bunclody G.A.A. Club at both Martin's removal and burial were testament to high esteem with which he is held in his native Parish.
